## The name of The Granada

It does not mean pomegranate, even though it is homonymous with the Spanish word for that oriental fruit and is pictured in The Granada crest, to the left.

The name comes from an ancient, but unknown word for **fortress** which the Romans Latinized as **Garnatum** (note fortress on the crest).

The Arabs pronounced it **Garnata** and it entered Castilian Spanish as **Granada**. Think about it, you in your fortress.

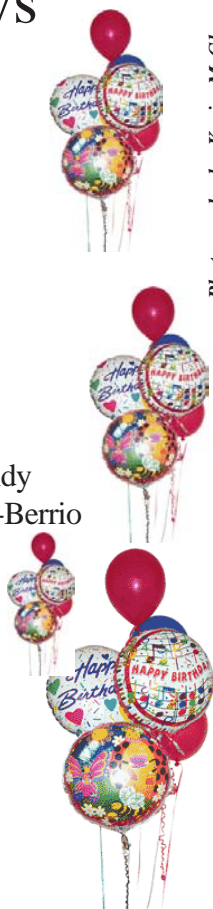
